



GIRLS SOFTBALL



Register for BPAA Girls Slow Pitch and Fast Pitch Softball one of three ways:

- 1) Online at www.webtrac.brooklynpark.org using Visa or Mastercard
- 2) Bring, fax or mail the completed form on the reverse side to the Brooklyn Park Community Activity Center service desk, (Located at 5600 85th Avenue North, Brooklyn Park) Fax: 763 493-8253
- 3) Call the community activity center and ask to register for BPAA Softball: 763-493-8333

The season runs April 28th through July 1st for girls ages 6 through 19.

Slow Pitch Softball: 8U (coach pitch, A & B divisions). 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U, 19U (girls pitch).

- Games played in Brooklyn Park primarily on weeknights in Brooklyn Park.
- Opening day on Sunday, May 1st for 8U, 10U and 12U.
- End of season weekend tournament in July.
- All Divisions are formed by age (as of Jan 1) according to USSSA rules
- 8u girls who have not played before may sign up for the “B” Division. Girls with playing experience should sign up for “A”.



Fast Pitch Softball: 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U, 19U (girls pitch all levels).

- A traveling league with games played on weekdays in the Northern and Western Suburbs
- Teams will play some weekends and season ends by July 23rd
- Registration runs from February 1 through March 16th, 2012
- Tryouts will be March 18th at Park Center High School between 1 and 8pm (check website for age group schedule, catcher & pitcher tryouts last ½ hour of each age group.) Limited opportunity for make-up on March 20th between 6-8pm. All try-outs are “closed” – only the players, coaches and independent evaluators allowed in the gym
- Depending on the number of girls trying out, we may have A & B or more teams in each age group
- Fees (\$185 for 10U and \$200 for all other ages) include league games, uniforms (jersey, pants, shorts, and socks.) For teams that play in State Qualifier and State Tournament there will be an additional cost for each of those tournaments. Some teams may decide to play additional tournaments during the season – there may be additional costs for those tournaments.
